What Can You Expect?


- ► Timely multidisciplinary assessments
- Collaborative treatment planning meetings that include the team, the patient and the family
- Encouragement of family members to actively participate in therapy sessions
- ▶ Bi-weekly team progress and review conferences
- No pre-determined visiting hours for friends and family. Visitation is encouraged and determined by each patient's condition and stage of recovery
- Regularly scheduled family conferences
- Weekend leaves of absence (LOA) as appropriate to assist with successful transition to home and community upon discharge

Inpatient Acquired Brain Injury Rehabilitation Program

The 10-bed Acquired Brain Injury Inpatient Program is one component of the rehabilitation continuum offered by Parkwood Hospital to persons with an acquired brain injury.



What Services Do We Provide?

Opportunities for individuals to regain and maintain an optimal level of physical, cognitive, and psychosocial independence based on patient and family focused rehabilitation goals.

The interdisciplinary team (IDT) of the inpatient brain injury program includes, but is not limited to:

- Clinical Nutrition
- ► Clinical Pharmacy
- Medicine
- Nursing
- Occupational Therapy
- Physiotherapy
- Psychiatry
- Psychology
- Social Work
- Speech Language Pathology
- ▶ Therapeutic Recreation

Since the Ministry of Health funds Parkwood Hospital, there are no costs associated with the inpatient program with regard to standard care and equipment.

Who Do We Serve?

Individuals over the age of 16 with an acquired brain injury who require intensive and comprehensive inpatient rehabilitation.

Individuals with an acquired brain injury living in the 10 counties of Southwestern Ontario (Bruce, Elgin, Essex, Grey, Huron, Kent, Lambton, Middlesex, Oxford and Perth).
